odd concrete sculptures which she calls her mecca a young woman who was once helped by miss helen has traveled hundreds of miles to help her in a time of crisis miss helen is in danger of being sent to an old folks home by a narrow minded minister who considers her sculptures a public nuisance a penetrating study of the role of the artist in any society this important play was produced in london and new york to great critical acclaim
